CONSERVATION PRACTICES:


- Revegetation of streambanks, forests
- Establishment of windbreaks, hedgerows
- Wetland restoration
- Grassed waterways
- Rangeland management: prescribed grazing, range planting
- Residue management: no-till
- Pasture and hay planting
- Compost application
- Nutrient management, fertilizer alternatives
- Crop rotations, cover cropping
