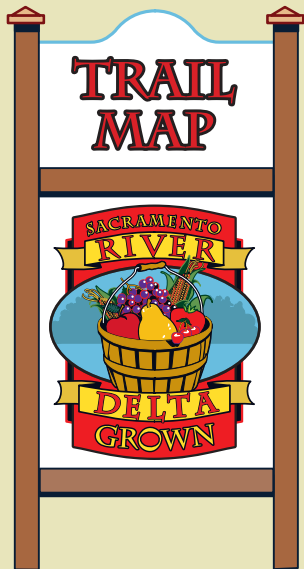

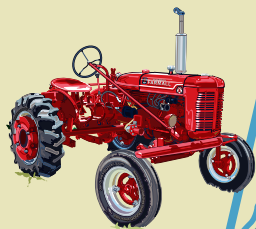

Things to Remember

Cash only at most farms.

Have a full tank of gas . . . the **ONLY** gas stations are in the towns of Walnut Grove and Rio Vista.

Bring an ice chest to keep produce and wine cool on warm days.

Farm Safety

Watch for slow moving tractors and large trucks hauling products on the farm and on roadways. Slow down on roads and pass only when appropriate and safe.

Read farm signs/information/rules before going out on the farm.

On the farm, remain in marked designated areas for your safety. Farms are active operations.

Follow all food safety procedures as posted by the farm.

Please deposit trash in provided trash containers or take it with you.

Don't climb trees or ladders.

You are responsible for your children and pets. Check to see if pets are allowed.

Respect the property of our members.

If not sure, ask questions of what's appropriate.

2 Double M Farms FOUNDED IN 1947 McDowell Hunting Preserve

13161 Grand Island Rd. Walnut Grove 95690
 The farm was started by our grandfather, Charlie McDowell, in 1947. The original farm came with 18 acres of pears which are now more than 100 years old. Current crops include pears, alfalfa, corn, wheat, safflower, and a small specialty fruit orchard. Visitors can stop by for seasonal pear-U-pick (mid July-mid Aug) and a farm stand (year round) offering free-range eggs and pear wood (for BBQing) and a variety of stone fruit throughout the summer. Check website for fruit variety harvest dates. **Stand hours are 8AM-6PM daily**, self-serve.

When the McDowells noticed a drop in the wild pheasant population on the island, Michael McDowell (Charlie's grandson) raised pheasants as a high school FFA project. After college Michael opened the hunting preserve, which now raises 5 breeds of pheasants, chukar, and quail.

Trap shooting: 2nd and 4th Thursdays of the month May-Sept, and by appointment. Hunting season: mid Oct-Jan by appointment only. Butchered whole birds can be ordered Oct-Jan.

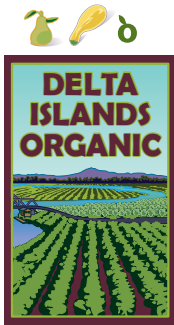

Delta Islands Organic began in 2008 with 50 tomato plants. "We had extra tomatoes, so we put them out front in a small stand." Farmer J.B. Morais transitioned to organic and now grows 40 varieties of heirloom tomatoes, hot & sweet peppers, cucumbers, beans, summer squash & zucchini, eggplant, herbs, onions, garlic and the sweetest watermelons around. Fall brings winter squash and a local pumpkin patch. **Stop by the roadside farm stand from mid June through Halloween.** Check their website for hours and special events.
