11/25/2015	L	1.5	I had my first meeting today. Since there was only one member besides me, we decided on projects pretty easily. We were going to make autumn mason jars, with multicolored leaves attached with modge podge. First we put down a base coat of modge podge, and then after it dried we got craft glue and attached the leaves since they weren't sticking very well with the other glue we tried. Once all the leaves were attached and glued on, we covered it with a finishing layer of modge podge and let it dry for a half hour. In the end, I put a candle in mine and it looked pretty good. Our leader discussed with us what projects we might like to do for our next meeting, and we decided on doing candles with cinnamon sticks, and a Christmas tree made out of sticks and ribbon.
12/19/2015	L	1.5	At this meeting, we made cinnamon stick candles and ribbon Christmas trees. The cinnamon stick candle was simple, we got a basic candle, then got a hot glue gun and glued the cinnamon sticks to the candle. To add a more festive touch to it, we chose two types of ribbon and tied them around the center of the candle. Our next project was a little bit harder, we had to choose multiple ribbon patterns and tie them around a short stick. It was difficult because the knots I tied the strings with all made the string end up different lengths, so it didn't look very good.
1/24/2016	L	2	We started a new project today that we had discovered while looking for an idea. It was called string art, and it's when you print a design, place it on a wooden board, put down nails around the pattern, and then weave string through it. I chose to do a simple cross, so first I had to print the pattern off the computer. Then, I had to paint my board. I chose a baby blue color, as it would coordinate well with my black and white string. After the paint dried, I took my pattern and glued it onto

			the paper. Next, I took the nails and nailed them around the pattern. Unfortunately, I ran out of nails three-quarters of the way through, so my leader promised she would get more nails for the next time that I came over.
2/27/2016	L	1	I finished working on my nail cross from the last meeting. It took a while, but after winding the string throughout all the corners I finally finished it. The color of the string went really well with baby blue I used as the background.
