The process to prepare and run this event worked with our small numbers. We had a system in place when we arrived although we had never been involved with this event before. There were very few desserts submitted (10) which meant that we could have plates out for one session while filling the plates for the next session. There were 3 judges that got to work right away because one of the categories to judge was appearance. A few of the desserts were difficult to plate because they needed spoons and small cups to be put into. Fortunately, one of the members who brought a non-finger food dessert also supplied us with those items so it worked.

Suggestions for next year, don't have categories such as "Cakes", "Chocolate Bars", and "Non-Chocolate Bars" on the check-in sheet or rubrics. When the scoresheets go to the tabulations area, they take the scores and decide who gets medal through cuts. They will not award based on category. The cuts really should be made by each age group so there can be at least 3 medalists but that's up to them.

We served milk in 3-5 oz. cups and the members really appreciated it. Our Committee wore our club's aprons so no whites were necessary.

- Stapler (to attach multiple judging rubrics for the same member)

- Sharpies to mark paper plates with People's Choice #
- Pencils for judges
- Pencils (golf-sized) for members to vote for People's Choice

- Blank judging rubrics for all age categories (color coded and can be made by county office)
- Check-in sheets with number labels for items
- Paper cups (3-5 oz.) if serving milk for members in rotations
- Tablecloths for facility tables (can buy at Dollar Store)
- Aprons for work staff
- People's Choice Award (1st place with an optional 2nd place)
- Hand washing soap for kitchen area
- Hand sanitizer for counter area
- Master paper for taking notes

Fantastic Field day dessert contest examples



Practice tasting! After looking at the baked good for “appearance” they could use their hands to see the “texture”.



This is the practice tasting meeting using the scorecard. Make sure it is understood.



Looks like this was a year of round tables which made it hard for the volunteers to manage the members walking around tasting.

Will your club have long rectangle tables? Be thinking about how to manage the members walking and tasting.

Remember, the members tasting in the sessions are not the judges for the contest – just the people's Choice. the committee members are the judges for the gold medal contest.



The committee makes all the signage to show where to drop off baked goods or what to do. We have aprons for the committee members to wear. Hair tied back and gloves.



Have a calm adult who can work with the committee members as they judge. They need to be there the whole time. Have another adult managing all the baked goods and adding up score cards
This was the judging area in a kitchen (2012)



2016 - However, you can talk to the club in charge and request a walkthrough or a layout in advance so they can move you in a place that works.



There is a kitchen in the room but the coordinating club used it as a snack area. Ask to see your area ahead of time!



2016 - I think the submission were so low they just let the kids taste everything.



2016 - Final scores are taken to a tabulations room. This is where the tabulations are documented and the winners get their gold medal placed on the certificate.

People's choice winners are determined by the dessert club committee.

THE DANISH JUDGING SYSTEM

WHY THE DANISH SYSTEM TO JUDGE 4-H CONTEST ENTRIES?

Provides recognition for a maximum number of exhibits or contestants.

Recognizes the existence of and allows for relatively minor differences of entries and performances.

DEFINITION - A method of evaluating a participant's product, skill, or exhibit relative to the standards developed for that class or contest.

CONSIDERATIONS

Items should be judged against standards, not against other items.

Exhibitor should not be judged. Only the product, exhibit, or performance of the exhibitor should be judged. Judge should not assume experience because of age.

In 4-H most judging involves the Danish system of judging. In this system, the judges do not judge one person's work by comparing it to another's. The evaluation is made against a standard. A judge looks to see whether requirements are met.

To plan, practice, and present a finished product is to "learn by doing." To graciously accept constructive criticism of one's work is a real life experience. 4-H'ers learn quickly that judging results reflect a personal opinion, and that evaluation will vary among judges.

THE FOUR GROUPS may consist of the following:

Gold excellent; exhibit most nearly meets the standard (does not indicate perfection). Example of a numerical score = 90 -100.

Blue - good; relative to pre-established standards, a few specific shortcomings have been identified. Example of a numerical score = 80-89.

Red - fair; many improvements are needed in order for the exhibit to meet the pre-established standards. Example of a numerical score =70-79.

White No award - far below standards expected for that exhibit. Example of a numerical score - 69 - below.

LASTLY

The purpose of recognition are to reinforce the motivation of members and volunteers to successfully participate, create and achieve in the 4-H YDP; and to emphasize a sense of belonging and being valued in the 4-H YDP community. 4-H YDP recognition programs should provide all youth, regardless of ability, with this motivation and a sense of belonging.
