

**Intermediate DIY Rules**

This project is for members who want to complete various DIY projects. Intermediate DIY is open to all 4-H members 9 years and older who have completed the requirements in rule #9. Projects available to complete will depend on age and experience. To make this project fun and successful here are a few rules to follow:

1. Members are asked to be on time to meetings and to notify leader if they will be absent. Parents are asked to communicate with Project leader if their child is not attending or if they will be leaving the meeting early.
2. Members may be asked to help contribute to supplies or money to help pay for supplies and materials. Or may be asked to bring specific items for that day's meeting.
3. Members will be courteous to each other and adults present.
4. Members are asked to complete their own project. Adult help may be needed at times but projects not completed by the members themselves cannot be shown at local fairs.
5. Leaders will help guide members to choose projects that are age appropriate. Older members who chose bigger projects must be willing to commit the time needed to finish them.
6. It is suggested (but not required) that each member enters a project into one of the local fairs or other shows arranged by the club.
7. To complete this project, the member must attend all hours of instruction offered that are necessary to complete their project. At least one "make up" meeting will be offered to maintain the hours required to complete this project successfully and be eligible to return next year and count in your record book. Member and leader must agree upon, and complete the makeup meeting. All members must complete 6 hours of instruction but the final number of hours needed to complete their projects may be more.
8. As with all projects, to complete the project it is required that you complete the Annual Project Report Form and include it in your record book. The leader may request to see a draft of the APR at any time. The Project Leader will set a date to sign APRs prior to record books being due.
9. Due to safety constraints and limited availability of tools the Intermediate DIY project is limited to 12 members who are 9 years and older and should have completed a beginning DIY project or demonstrated the necessary safety skills to be in the project. Beginning members will be allowed to enroll, if the enrollment of the project falls under 12 members, limited to only 2 new members per year. Members will be chosen by lottery Aug 1<sup>st</sup> after enrollment has been turned in for the 4-H year, your enrollment must be turned into to the club enrollment coordinator by the due date set by the club to be eligible.
10. Be **creative**, help others and have fun!!
