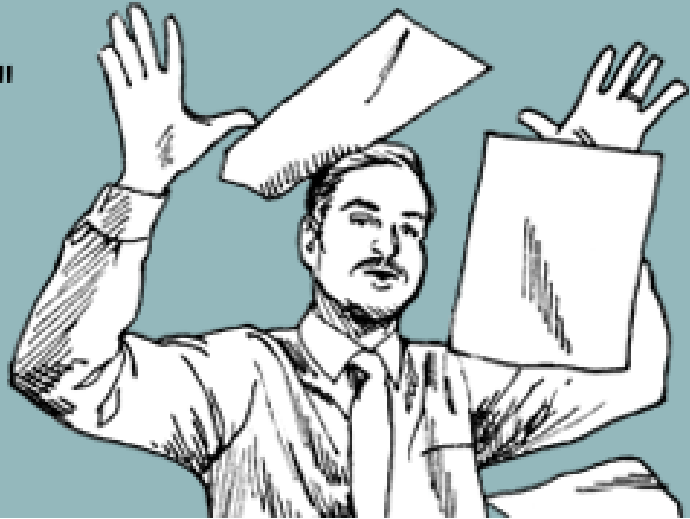

Notice of Intent

- ▶ Date of intended application must be submitted 24 hrs prior to application
- ▶ Permit number
- ▶ Name and address of permittee and applicator
- ▶ Location of area to be treated
- ▶ Crop/commodity
- ▶ Approximate acreage
- ▶ Method of application
- ▶ Pesticide
- ▶ Dilution
- ▶ Pest to be controlled

Headquarter Inspection

- ▶ If any employees
 - ▶ Training required
 - ▶ Another option: employee obtains PAC
- ▶ PUR's- current & 2 previous years
- ▶ Op-ID/RM- current & 2 previous years
- ▶ PUR's submitted by the 10th of the following month that you apply

Headquarter Inspection-Storage

- ▶ Storage containing Warning/Danger materials must be posted
- ▶ Readable at a distance of 25ft



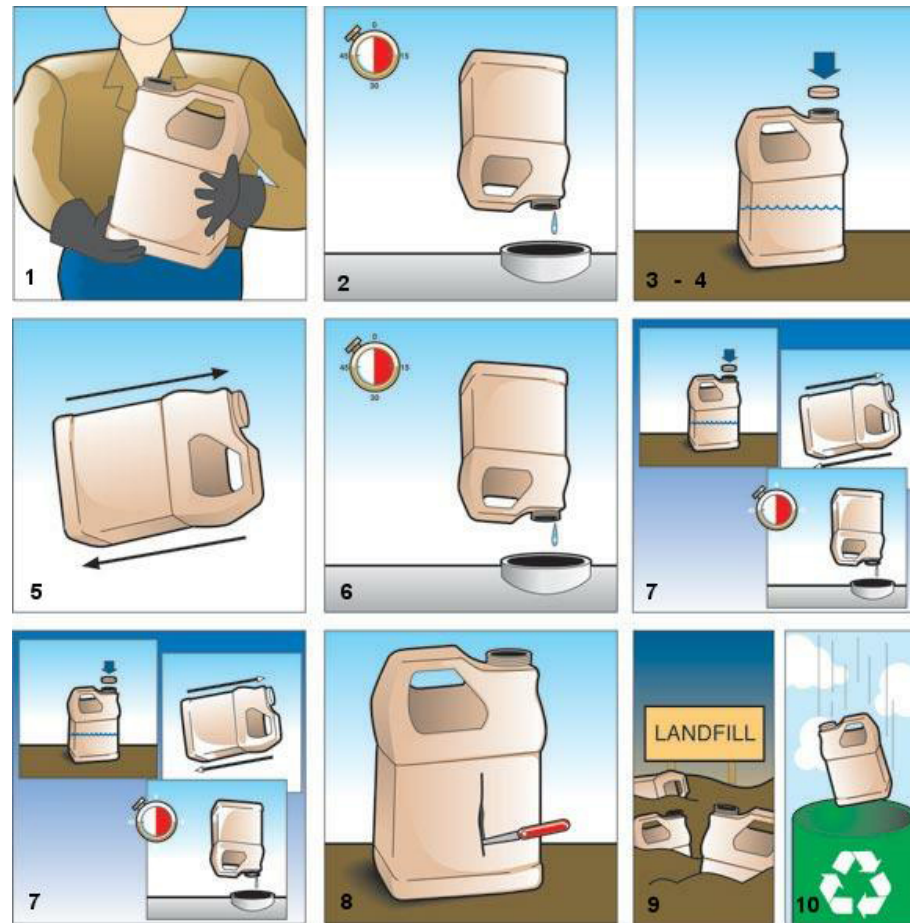
Headquarter Inspection-Storage



- ▶ Pesticide Storage
 - ▶ Permit for all RM's
 - ▶ Containers secured
 - ▶ Containers must be properly labeled and securely tightened
 - ▶ Do not store pesticides near food, animal feed, or personal protective equipment.
 - ▶ Proper containers

Headquarter Inspection-Storage

- ▶ You must rinse and empty out pesticide containers properly. Empty containers must be disposed of the right way.
 - ▶ Triple rinsed
- ▶ San Martin Hazardous Waste Disposal Site-recycling program
- ▶ 1st Friday and Saturday of month
 - ▶ Lids, foil, and plastic sleeves/label booklets must be removed



Application Inspection

- ▶ THE LABEL IS THE LAW
- ▶ Label must be available at use site
- ▶ Follow label site/rate and label requirements
- ▶ PPE regulations from label must be followed.



Application Inspection

- ▶ Protections of persons, animals & property- before applying
 - ▶ Evaluate equipment
 - ▶ Surrounding property, and property to be treated
 - ▶ Weather



Application Inspection

- ▶ Backflow prevention airgap



Application Inspection

- ▶ Containers secured/attended to
- ▶ Proper transport
 - ▶ No pesticides in vehicle cab

Important Reminder: SCHOOL NOTIFICATIONS

- ▶ Schools & Pre-schools/Daycares
- ▶ Notify all schools within ¼ mile of your farm
- ▶ Notify the Agriculture Office
- ▶ Annually by April 30th
- ▶ Cannot spray from 6 am to 6 pm during school days
- ▶ ¼ mile to 25 foot buffer zone
 - ▶ Depends on what pesticides are being used
 - ▶ Greenhouse exception for buffer zone is 0 feet for most pesticides
- ▶ Regulation is complicated, we will walk you through process if applicable to your site





Important Reminders

Bud Break & 2, 4-D

- ▶ For sites located within $\frac{1}{2}$ from a vineyard
- ▶ March 15th is cut off for applications
- ▶ If wanting to apply 2, 4-D after March 15th special approval is required from Ag Biologist
