

Evaluation Report for Bay Area Community Resources 2019 LEAP Summer Program

Agriculture and Natural Resources | 4-H Youth Development Program

From June to July 2019, approximately 340 first through eighth grade students responded to an online survey. Most youth reported that they identified as Hispanic or Latino (n=275); 173 male and 136 female.

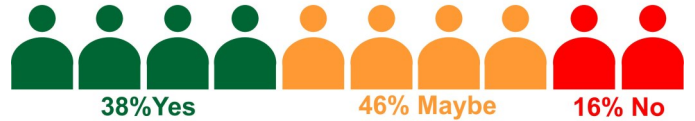

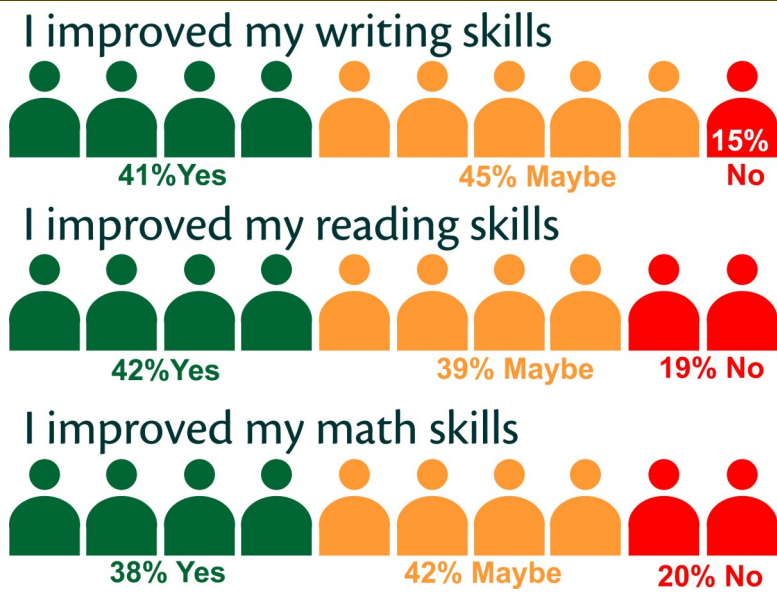

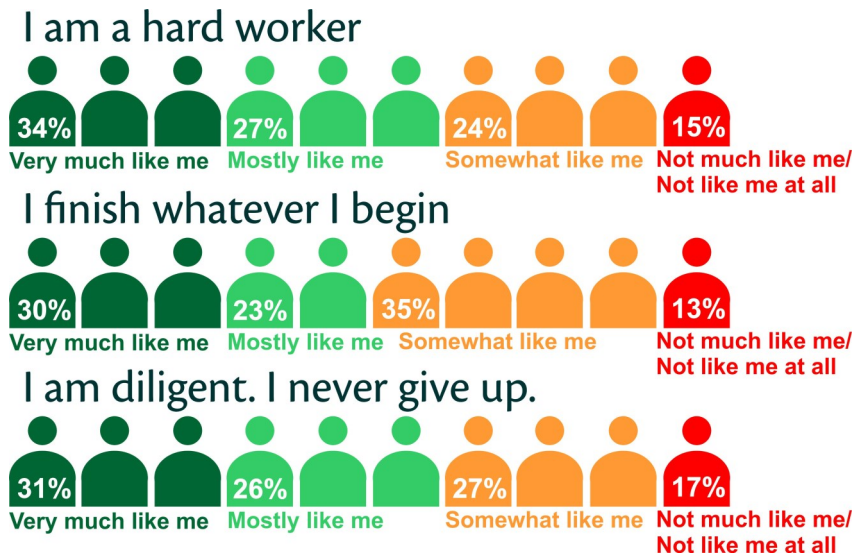
Grades 4th to 8th—Improvements to Math, Reading, and Writing (n=195)



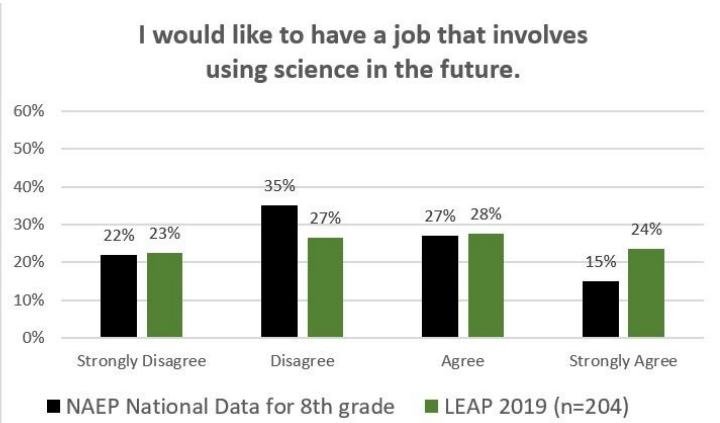
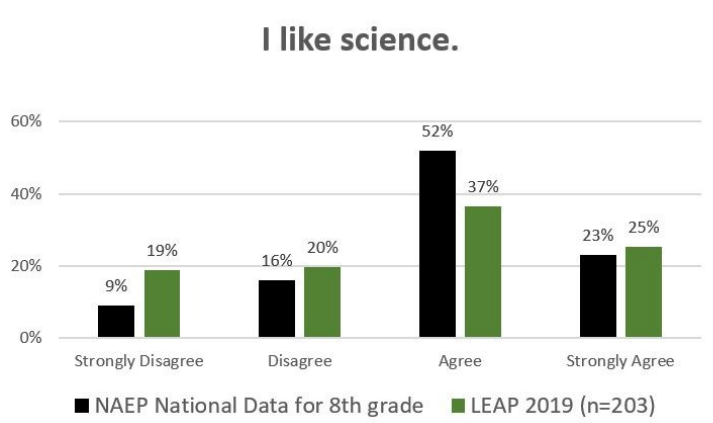
GRIT

Grit is the tendency to sustain interest in and effort toward very long-term goals.
 No statistically significant differences from pre-test to post-test.

3.1 average grit
 The maximum is 5 (extremely gritty) and the lowest is 1 (not at all gritty).
