4-H VISA DEBIT CARD CONTINUED

HOW DOES IT WORK

Merchants pay "interchange fees" to banks every time they accept a card as payment. As a social purpose corporation, GroundSwell directs a portion of these fees to support mission-driven nonprofits and organizations like 4-H. Because it happens from merchant fees there is no extra cost to you. We believe this "unseen money" is better spent on great causes, than supporting big banks as usual.

PLEASE NOTE: THIS IS NOT A GUARANTEE OF A SHOW. THIS CONCEPT STILL NEEDS TO BE VOTED ON AND APPROVED BY THE IV EXPO BOARD OF DIRECTORS, THEN APPROVED BY IMPERIAL COUNTY AND OUR STATE. ALSO, PLEASE REMEMBER THAT THE DEADLINE TO REGISTER FOR THE 4-H PROGRAM YEAR IS NOVEMBER 9, 2020

Presently, the IV Expo Livestock Committee is looking to present the following show concept to the IV Expo Board of Directors for a vote:

•Hold a grading show for youth who choose to raise an animal.

•Show will be terminal. No animal that enters the IV Expo property for the show will be allowed to leave nor will the animal be able to be sold to anyone other than the designated processor.

•Exhibitors will receive market price for the animal; the fair will create an online add-on process to allow for the community to contribute to the exhibitors.

•All animals will be classed based on weights; no breed classes.

•4-H & FFA will show together unless numbers justify showing separate.

•DNA will be required.

YOCA will be required.

The animals that can be considered "market" are still to be determined, along with many other decisions which still need to be made. Again, this is all predicated on the board approving the recommendations of the livestock committee and then that the County and State allow for the show. Ultimately the decision is not up to IV EXPO.

Please know that the IV Expo staff and board are doing everything they can to create some form of a show for our youth. We all recognize how important this program is and how much our members grow and learn from these projects. We will be sure to keep everyone posted and send official word once we receive it.
