## Healthy Soils Program

- Do not start your practices until you receive your executed grant agreement
- You should have received an email from CDFA with the estimated arrival date of your grant agreement
- If you did not get that email, reach out to Shulamit Shroder at <u>sashroder@ucanr.edu</u> or 661-903-9442 and she'll find out the information for you
- The CDFA estimates that most remaining recipients will receive their grant agreements in the next 30 to 45 days
- If you are not able to do your first year's practice, that's okay. You can still do it next year and get it reimbursed next year.
