What to do in your garden in January

Planning

- Develop garden plans for the year
- Review current seed inventory
- Review seed catalogs
- Order seeds
- Crop rotation



Tools

- Check tools for dirt and rust
- Sharpen, clean and oil as needed to protect them
- Replace cracked handles
- Any new tools needed for this years garden plan?

A good pruner is essential



Soil Management

- During wet months, do no harm to soil structure to avoid compaction
- Keep off wet soil and refrain from working wet soil
- Acquire materials for making compost, mulching and amending soil

Mulch



Weeds

- Control weeds while they are small by hand picking, hoeing, smothering with mulch or sheet mulching
- Look up: ucipm sheetmulch

Pest Control

- Watch for and remove slugs and snails
- Control peach leaf curl by spraying with a copper based fungicide if have not done yet
- Repeat in February just before bud break if rainfall is heavy

Sanitation

 A clean garden discourages snails, slugs, earwigs and disease



Frost Protection

- Cover tender citrus trees
- Do not let the cover touch the plant
- A top cover is more important than a side cover
- Well watered plants are more resistant to frost damage
- If severe frost is anticipated add heat

Plant Vegetables

- Plant starts of artichokes and asparagus
- Plant onion seedlings and garlic sets
- Plant seeds of kale, parsley, radishes and spinach directly in the ground



• Pick lettuce and other leaf crops





Root crops





• Peas



- Brassicas
- Check occasionally for maturity especially broccoli and cauliflower from which we eat the flower bud

Plant trees

- Purchase and plant bare root fruit trees
- Check soil moisture before planting
- May need to create a "dry zone" by covering soil with a tarp to dry out soil before planting
