Baking, cooking, holiday decorations, and judging event open to all Fresno County 4-H'ers Simply choose your favorite recipe, make the item, displayed with decorations, and join the fun!

This is a great learning experience and 4-H tradition. *Pre-Registration is REQUIRED*. Youth must set up displays unassisted and wait for the judging to begin. **Entries MUST be checked in between 11:00 am - 12:00 pm; Building closed during judging.** Showmanship opportunity offered between 12:00 pm – 12:15 pm. Dress neatly, 4-H Uniform encouraged yet optional. Showmanship presentation limited to ONE category entry only. Additional activities include Consumer Science & Plants Judging Contest, Community Service Activity, and Bingo. Awards ceremony and special presentations begin at conclusion of judging. Then we eat!

GUIDELINES TO FOLLOW FOR FESTIVE FAIRE

- 1. A total of one entry for each category may be entered. Each food entry must have its own display.
- 2. Pre-entry is required. Find entry link on Fresno County 4-H website.
- 3. No meat items allowed unless specified by category description.
- 4. Contestant must set up their own display. No help is to be given. Limited to 12" x 12" space per entry.
- 5. Exhibit should be attractively displayed, (place mat, decorations, etc.)
- 6. May choose any holiday or special occasion themes. (birthdays, graduation, etc.)
- 7. <u>COMPLETE RECIPES MUST BE INCLUDED</u>, printed or typed, on recipe cards:

 MUST include category and division on front.- for category 8 complete a title card

 NAME/CLUB ON BACK- on all recipes and title cards
- 8. All displays must be in place for judging by 12:00 pm. (late entries will not be accepted)
- 9. All 4-H Members are eligible to participate.
- 10. Primary members may enter the Primary Age Division only. (awarded participation ribbons only).

We do not want to disappoint you; <u>Your recipes must fall within one of the listed categories or it will be disqualified.</u> Categories subject to change annually. Verify categories by clicking on the list found on county website.

Awards may include medals, ribbons, gift cards and special prizes!
