February ...... Begin work on posters! Please include all the information listed below!!!

April ....... Posters are judged at the April CCC meeting on April 1st, 2025. Only one poster per age division

per club will be judged! One winner and two runners up in each age division (except for Primary Members) will be awarded and receive pins. All Primary Members will receive a participation pin. All posters will be returned to the club at the end of April CCC meeting to be displayed in the community. The winning posters may be returned by Sunday May 4th to be

displayed at the Chicken Que event.

## **AGE DIVISIONS**

Primary Members...... Aged 8 and under – *Receive a participation pin* 

Junior...... 9 and 10 years old - Receive a pin Intermediate...... 11 – 13 years old - Receive a pin Senior ...... 14 – 19 years old - *Receive a pin* 

Adult ...... 19 and over – Receive a special award, not a pin
