• This show welcomes riders of both owned and leased horses in the same classes. Shared horses within same club is acceptable. All riders must be current 4-H members and enrolled in the horse project. Neighboring county riders are welcome. Horse must be declared and recorded on Horse ID Certificate.

• The age divisions will combine for both owned, leased, or borrowed horses. Horses can be shared, however if a rail class only one rider may enter. Pattern classes may accommodate multiple riders. Only horseless members may borrow a horse.

• Class placing 1st-6^{th.} Rosettes - High Point buckles awarded in 1st yr/novice , junior and senior of English, Western and Gymkhana. Class must have 3 or more riders to count towards buckle high point award.

• NO GREEN or PONY Divisions – Show consists of 1st yr/walk/jog/trot, Junior lope/canter, and Senior lope/canter. The Horse Project Leader will make the determination if the rider is qualified to show as Junior or Senior.

• Management may combine classes due to lack of entries. Gate hold for tack/rider change will not exceed **3 minutes**.

• ATTIRE: All riders will wear Fresno County 4-H horse project attire, to consist of long sleeve, white, button up, collared shirt, 4-H emblem scarf or tie, English breeches, blue or black jeans, boots (no athletic shoes), belt and riding helmet (approved and properly fitting). Gloves are optional. No western chaps, English jackets, or vests (protective vests are acceptable). Jackets and/or sweatshirts are allowed due to cold weather but entry number must be clearly visible.

• Out of County Riders: Are responsible for reading the ATTIRE section of this entry and dressing accordingly. Must obtain leaders signature on entry. If horse leader is not at the show, entry form should include phone number of Horse Project Leader, and a letter stating your child is a member in good standing. Must be accompanied by parent/guardian. Horse ID certificate must be completed and submitted.

• Ranch Riding class will be on pattern. Ranch Pleasure will be on rail.

• The Show Manager oversees the operation and management of the 4-H Club Horse Show. Their decisions will be respected. The manager can excuse anyone from the show. The manager will document the incident and turn into Fresno County 4-H Office by the following week.
