



Cost- \$2 per class including showmanship. All animal entries are due to the 4-H office by May 2<sup>nd</sup>. Paper entry cards required for all animal contests. Payment due to club or project leader with entry.

Animal maximum entry fees of \$15 per member and \$25 maximum per family not to include still exhibits.

Separate maximum on still exhibits of \$2 each entry with a maximum of \$10 per member and \$20 per family. Still exhibit fees will be collected at check-in. NOTE- All stills must have entry cards completed in advance. Cards found on county 4-H websites Annual Events page.



#### Pygmy Show includes - Showmanship, Doe Classes & Wether Classes

A limited number of pens will be available, Clubs will need to share. Primary may participate as non-competitive, limited to participation ribbons only.

All animals must be in good health, free of parasites, washed and groomed upon arrival.

### Rabbit Show – Registration deadline May 2nd

All animals must be in good health. Cost: \$2 per class including showmanship. Members must be present when rabbits are being judged. All categories found in small animal handbook available on county 4-H website- annual events page.
